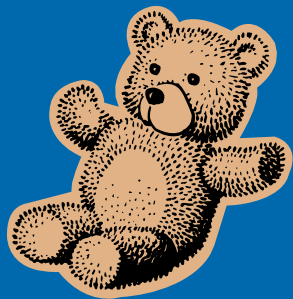


Little Beacons Vacation Programme
