Beaconhills College's contemporary uniform - from Early years to Year 12 - meets the learning needs of all students.

OUR UNIFORM

Retaining the historical links to Beaconhills colours, our quality, all-season uniform is both smart and comfortable. It is designed to promote physical activity, positive body image and offers flexibility in student choice.

It is important that students wear the uniform correctly – and with pride.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The College has two main variations of our school uniform to best meet the needs of our program.

- The formal uniform - the academic 'wardrobe' - is a range of connected all-season garments. Students can choose to wear items on any day of the year suited to the weather and to reflect their personal preference and identity. There is no separate 'summer' or 'winter' uniform (although navy tights can only be worn with the Beaconhills tunic or tartan skirt).
- The sport uniform is worn for Physical Education, sporting competitions, practical Sport and Physical Education classes and activities that relate to our experiential learning programs.
- Items from the formal uniform and the sport uniform should not be combined.
- Non-uniform items should not be worn.
- The formal uniform is the standard school uniform that should be worn each day, unless the sport uniform is specified for a particular excursion or activity.
- There is an age-appropriate approach regarding change between the sport uniform and the formal uniform (FAQs).

Wearing the uniform correctly gives students a sense of pride and connection to the College. All uniform items should be worn clean and in good condition.

MIDDLE TO SENIOR SCHOOL (YEARS 5-12)

The formal academic all-season or sport uniform applies to these year levels, with the key difference that ties are not compulsory in Years 5-8. Blazers are also introduced from Year 5 as part of the formal uniform and must be worn travelling to and from school each morning (except travelling home in hot weather during terms 1 and 4).

Girls now have the option to wear a skirt, a dress, shorts or long pants.

- Shell jacket with the College logo (can be worn outside at school or with the sport uniform).

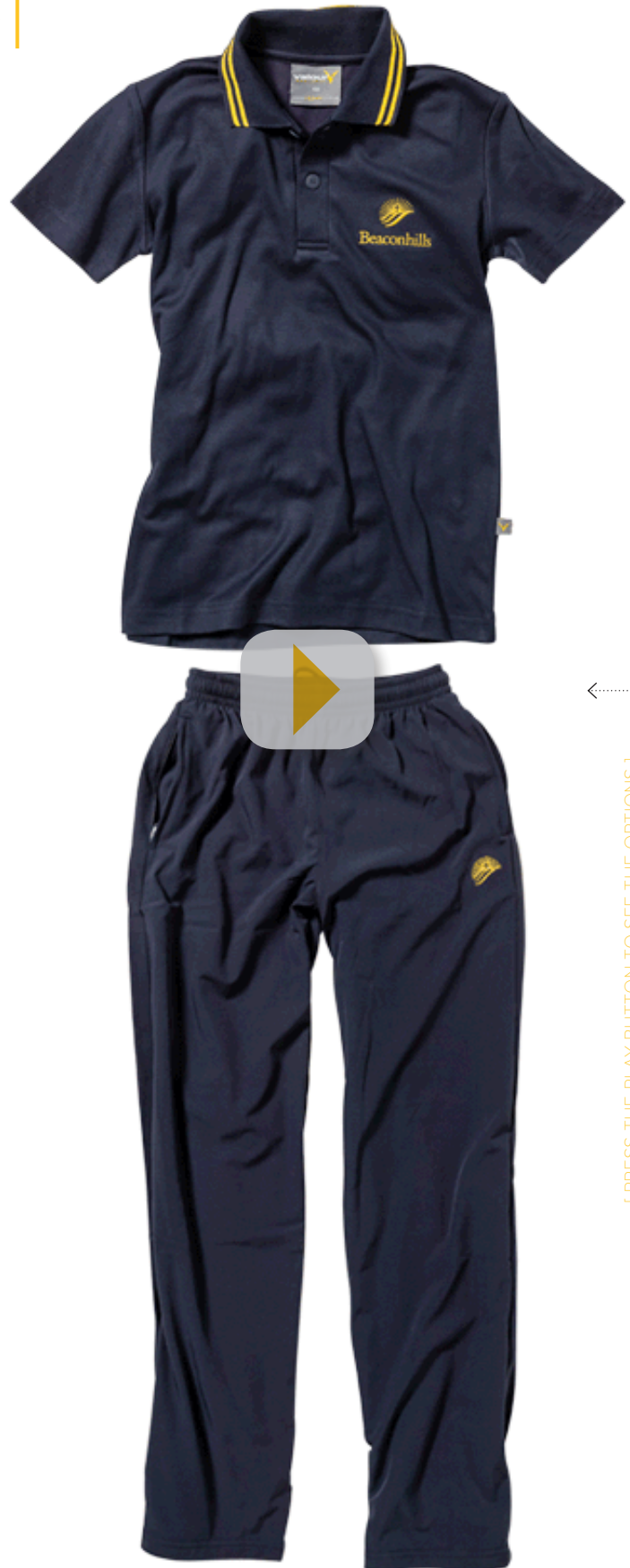

WHEN SHOULD STUDENTS WEAR THE COLLEGE BLAZER?

- When in formal uniform, students from Years 5-12 should wear the blazer travelling to and from school.
- In terms 1 and 4, Years 5-12 students must always wear their blazers to school but do not need to wear them home in the hot weather. However, the jumper should never be the outermost garment.
- Year 12 students may wear their Year 12 jacket in place of the College blazer to and from school.
- Years 5-12 students must wear the blazer to all formal school occasions, such as assemblies and church services.

WHEN CAN STUDENTS WEAR THE SOFT SHELL JACKET?

Students may wear the soft shell jacket as part of the sport uniform.

Students may also wear the soft shell jacket to accompany the formal uniform in wet weather to or from school and outside. The shell jacket should not be worn to replace the blazer as the outermost garment for Years 5-12 students travelling to and from school. It should be worn over the blazer.

If students are in formal uniform, the soft shell jacket cannot be worn inside.

WHEN CAN STUDENTS WEAR TIGHTS?

The navy tights may only be worn with the skirt.

WHEN DO STUDENTS NEED TO TUCK IN THEIR SHIRTS?

Students must tuck in the long-sleeve shirts when wearing the formal uniform. The short-sleeve shirts have been designed with a band at the bottom and do not need to be tucked in.

WHEN DO STUDENTS WEAR THE COLLEGE TIE?

The College tie is worn with the long-sleeve shirt. It is optional for Middle School students to wear the tie but compulsory for Year 9 and Senior School students when wearing the long-sleeve shirt.

CAN STUDENTS WEAR BRANDED SOCKS WITH THE SPORT UNIFORM?

Students may wear either the Beaconhills socks or plain white socks. Socks with other logos or emblems are not permitted.

CAN CADETS WEAR THEIR CADET UNIFORM TO SCHOOL?

Students in the Cadet Program are able to wear their cadet uniform to school on Thursday and as instructed for special occasions.

WHAT IS THE POLICY ABOUT CHANGING INTO THE SPORT UNIFORM?

There is an age-appropriate approach regarding changing between the sport and formal uniform:

SENIOR SCHOOL (YEARS 10-12) – GET CHANGED POLICY

Senior School students are not allowed to arrive at school in the sport uniform. Students should change into their sport uniform before class and back into their formal uniform after their class. They can leave school in sport uniform if they have Physical Education in period 5 or SEISA training at lunchtime.

YEARS 7-9 - ONE CHANGE POLICY

If Physical Education is in periods 1 or 2, students are allowed to arrive to school in the sport uniform and then must change to their formal uniform after the class. Students who have Physical Education in periods 3, 4 or 5 must arrive in formal uniform, but can leave in sport uniform.

STUDENTS DO NOT NEED TO WEAR THEIR FORMAL UNIFORM ON THESE OCCASIONS:

Years 5-12

- if the student has Physical Education classes before recess
- if the student is participating in SEISA sport
- if the student has been instructed to wear their sport uniform for an experiential activity
- at inter-House carnivals (swimming, athletics, cross-country, performing arts)

- if the student is in the Cadet Unit
- on casual clothes days.

HAIR, NAILS AND MAKEUP?

Obvious makeup or coloured nail polish is not permitted. French tips are allowed. For Prep to Year 8, hair that is shoulder-length or longer should be neatly tied back off the face and collar with a navy, gold or tonal hair fastener. Ribbons in House colours from the uniform shops may be worn.

For students in Years 9-12, hair must be off the face and tied back when instructed for classes. Students should be clean-shaven, unless they seek an exemption from the Headmaster based on cultural or religious reasons.
