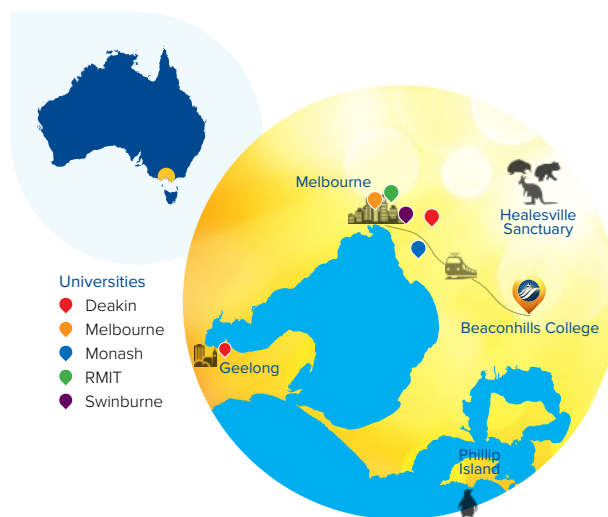
Accommodation

Homestay and boarding options (subject to availability) are only available to students aged 13 years or older.

Rates are:

Homestay	AUD \$461 per week
Boarding	AUD \$833 per week
Refundable bond*	AUD \$500

* Accommodation must be left clean, tidy and undamaged (homestay and boarding).



Airport pick-up

Airport pick-up	approx. AUD \$280
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Please advise full details of flight arrangements four weeks before your child arrives in Australia to ensure appropriate transport arrangements are in place. The College should be notified immediately if there are any changes to travel plans.

How to apply

Submit application form with all requested documentation. Once applications are reviewed, the international team will arrange interviews to meet applicants and determine English capacity. Students do not need a high level of English proficiency, but they must be able to understand what teachers are asking and be able to hold a basic conversation with peers. This is for the safety of the student within a school environment, as well as ensuring the student is placed into the appropriate year level.

Applicants must arrange their own travel or health insurance to cover them while they are in Australia.

Eligible applicants are Middle or Senior School (Year 5 and above). Students from Year 3 will be reviewed on a case by case basis in semester 2 only.

Accepting a place

Applications will be assessed and, if accepted, a placement will be confirmed. A Letter of Offer outlining course fees, terms and conditions will be sent directly to parents or the accredited agent.
